Enrollment in this program is ONLY required if you are located in Mexico and do one of the following:

- Export organic product directly to the EU or Switzerland.
- Provide final processing in Mexico for a product exported to the EU or Switzerland.
- The CCOF International Standard program is dependent on certification to the US National Organic Program as a base level of compliance.
